- [24] **Ann Jones:** Now that the Wales Women's National Coalition is no longer operating, who do you go to? It used to offer support in making sure that budgets did not necessarily discriminate against women. How are you going to do that now with this void?
- [25] Carl Sargeant: That is an interesting point that I have been toiling over for the last couple of months. We are in the process of trying to establish a body that will not take the place of the Wales Women's National Coalition, but will be a referral body that gives us the information that we need as a unit. I have had many discussions, including with the Women's Institute in Wales. I am currently in discussions with the Wales Council for Voluntary Action about how it can help us to develop the process. It has not fallen off the agenda. I recognise that there is a void that we need to fill rapidly.
