The United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child has urged the UK Government in 2008 to 'reconsider its policy of recruiting children to the armed forces.'

I very much hope that our National Assembly will respond positively to this call in our petition for schools in Wales to stop the armed forces from recruiting children.
