## 1. Welcome

Chair welcomed members and external invitees to the meeting of the Cross Party Group on UK Changing Union noting that this was the first meeting of the new term. The chair noted that he was pleased to welcome the guest speaker, Professor Michael Kenny from Queen Mary University London who was present to discuss England.

## 2. Guest speaker: Professor Michael Kenny, QMUL

Professor Kenny talked about the emerging visibility of Englishness which he noted predated devolution in 1990s. He also noted the significant rise in hostility linked to London with Englishness.

Professor Kenny also mentioned that there also positives to English political identity, include matters on place and locality, and the diversity of England itself. Professor Kenny also said that ethnic minorities are included within a growing sense of 'Englishness' but the big divide is with Muslim communities.

The chair then took questions to the panel from the invited audience. The topics that were raised included what can be done to address the disgruntlement the English feel, how does the Labour party react to the findings of the Future of England Survey, and would there be a move in English sentiment from the European Union towards the Commonwealth.
