#### Minutes

- 1. Darren Millar AM welcomed everyone and noted apologies.
- 2. The two speakers, Karin Cooke from The Naked Truth and Shereen Aziz-Williams from The Henna Foundation, were introduced and both gave ten-minute presentations on God and sex faith groups tackling pornography.
- 3. The presentations were followed by a time of discussion and Q&A.
- 4. Action points from the meeting were:
  - a. To write to Welsh Government asking what consideration has been given to making changes to the licensing system to restrict access to pornography.
  - b. To write to the Education Minister asking what is being done to further develop the curriculum in order to address problems caused by exposure to pornography
  - c. To write to the Education Minister asking if government guidance will be refreshed in order to equip teachers and those in school leadership to tackle the challenges presented by exposure to pornography by pupils and fellow staff members
  - d. To write to the First Minister asking what Welsh Government will do to expand counselling services to prevent pornography addiction and to aid recovery regarding problematic behaviour resulting from exposure to pornography.
